SINGING WITH GRACE IN YOUR HEARTS TO THE LORD

*“Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom;
teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and
spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”*

-Colossians 3:16

TEACHING:

Singing involves teaching, and what our songs should teach is what the Word of God teaches. We must remember our singing teaches, and make sure in our singing we teach what is true. There is great power to teach in singing.

As we all know, we sometimes find ourselves guilty of singing songs that do not teach us anything at all. Sadly this should not be. We as Christian men and women should sing songs that teach us about the Lord, the love He has for us and our love for Him. We as Christians should be cautious and reject words that are not scriptural or do not teach. This means we must pay attention to the words we sing and what each and every one of them mean.

ADMONISHING:

Webster’s definition of this eight-letter word is: “To warn a person to correct a fault.” There is power in singing to teach and to correct.

Once again, we could find ourselves singing songs that don’t do this in any way, shape, or form. Is that what we should be singing? Absolutely not. Our singing is right if it is right with the WORD OF GOD.

In closing, we should always strive to sing scripturally correct songs. And remember, always listen to what you’re singing. Don’t just run through words without actually reading them. Think about the words and what they mean.

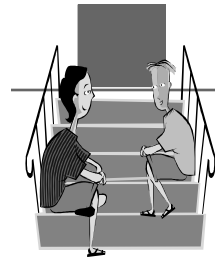
