"Where's Mom?"*

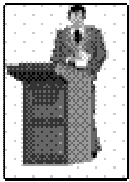
*I was their Dad, and could not see, why they asked for Mom instead of me.

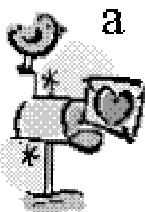

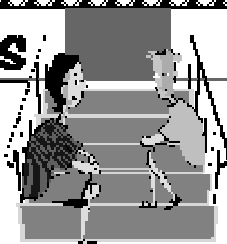

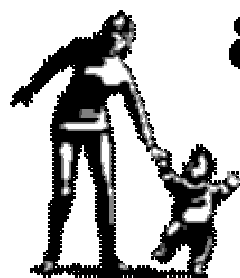
